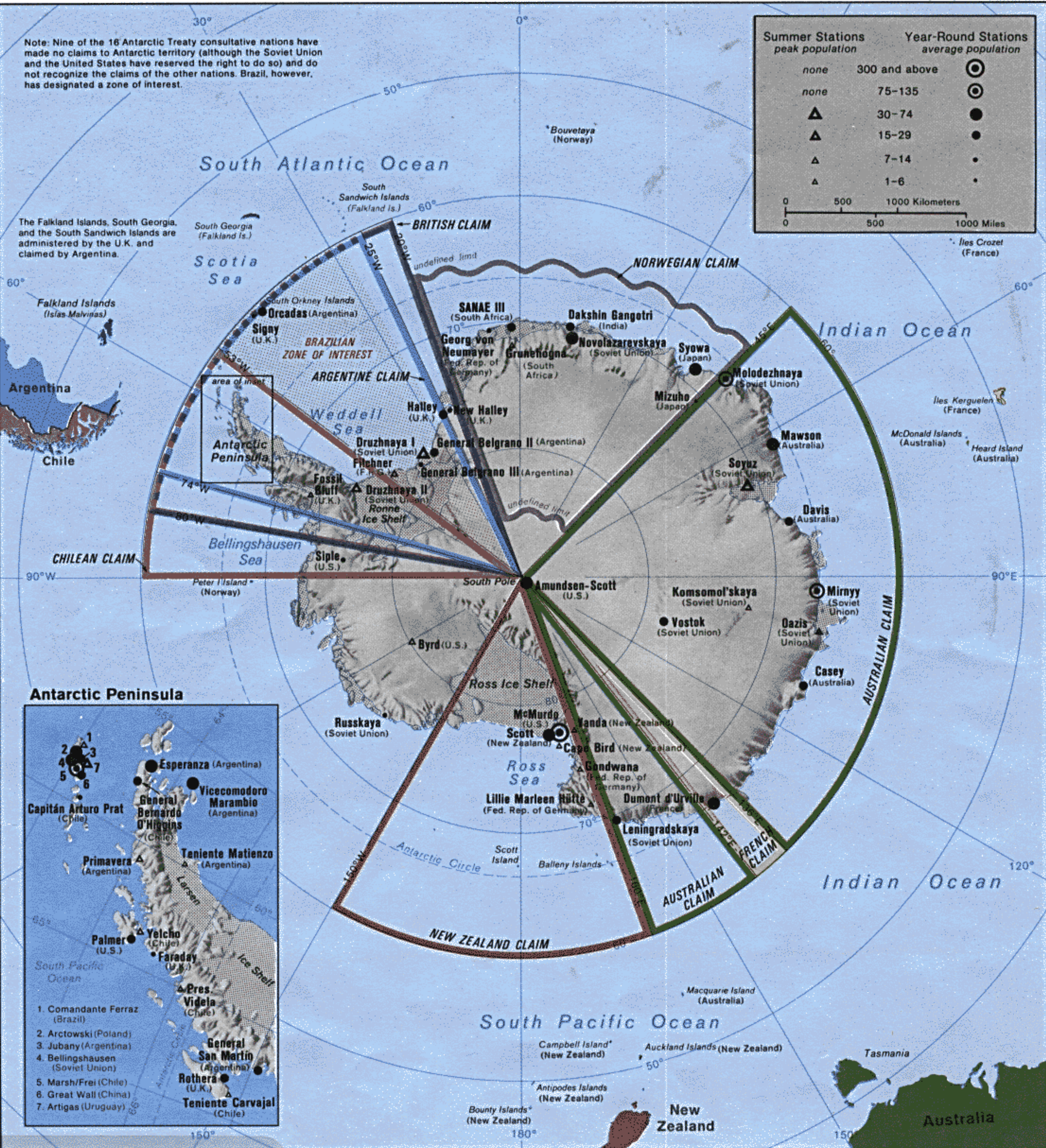


Antarctica: Research Stations and Territorial Claims

Note: Nine of the 16 Antarctic Treaty consultative nations have made no claims to Antarctic territory (although the Soviet Union and the United States have reserved the right to do so) and do not recognize the claims of the other nations. Brazil, however, has designated a zone of interest.
