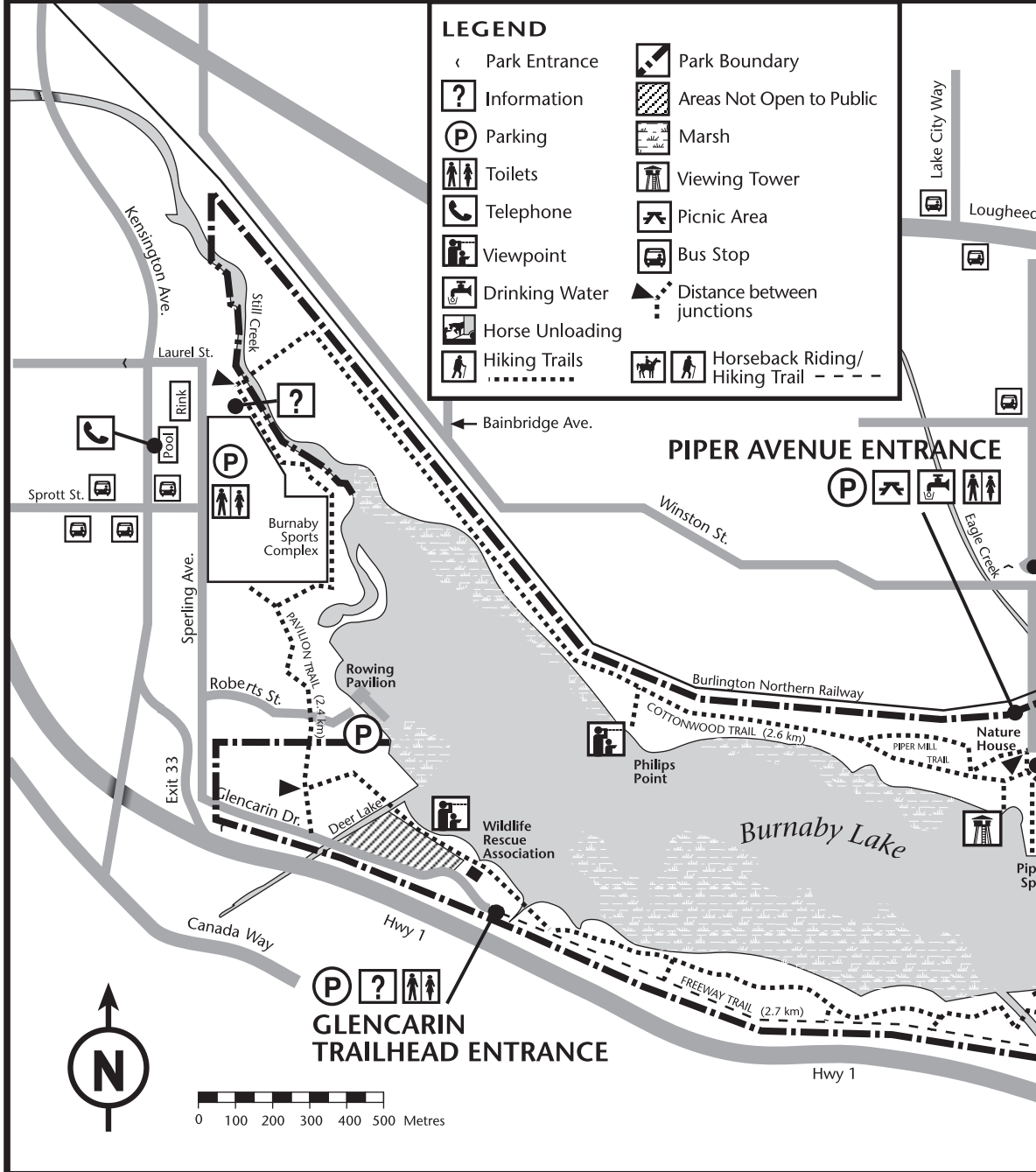


# BURNABY LAKE REGIONAL PARK

## HOW TO GET THERE

To reach the Nature House, traveling west along Lougheed Hwy, turn south on Brighton, west on Winston and south on Piper Avenue. If traveling east on the Lougheed Hwy, take the Winston Street exit, and turn south on Piper Avenue.

The Avalon Avenue Entrance can also be reached from Lougheed Hwy. Turn south on Brighton Ave. and then east onto Government St. From Government St., turn south over the railway tracks onto Cariboo Rd. Turn west onto Avalon Ave. at the Burnaby Equestrian Centre sign.

To reach the Wildlife Rescue Association from Lougheed Hwy., take the Kensington exit south and immediately get into the left lane. From the first left turn lane, turn east onto Laurel St. and then south onto Spertling Ave. Travel to the south end of Spertling Ave. which turns into Glencarin Dr. and watch for park signs.
