 Bushy Park is the second largest of the Royal Parks with an area of 445 hectares (1,099 acres). Lying to the north of Hampton Court Palace, the park has a distinctly rural character and is home to around 320 free-roaming deer. The famous Diana Fountain forms the centrepiece to Chestnut Avenue.
