Park users must remain on the trails at all times and obey all trail use control signs.

**THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED:**

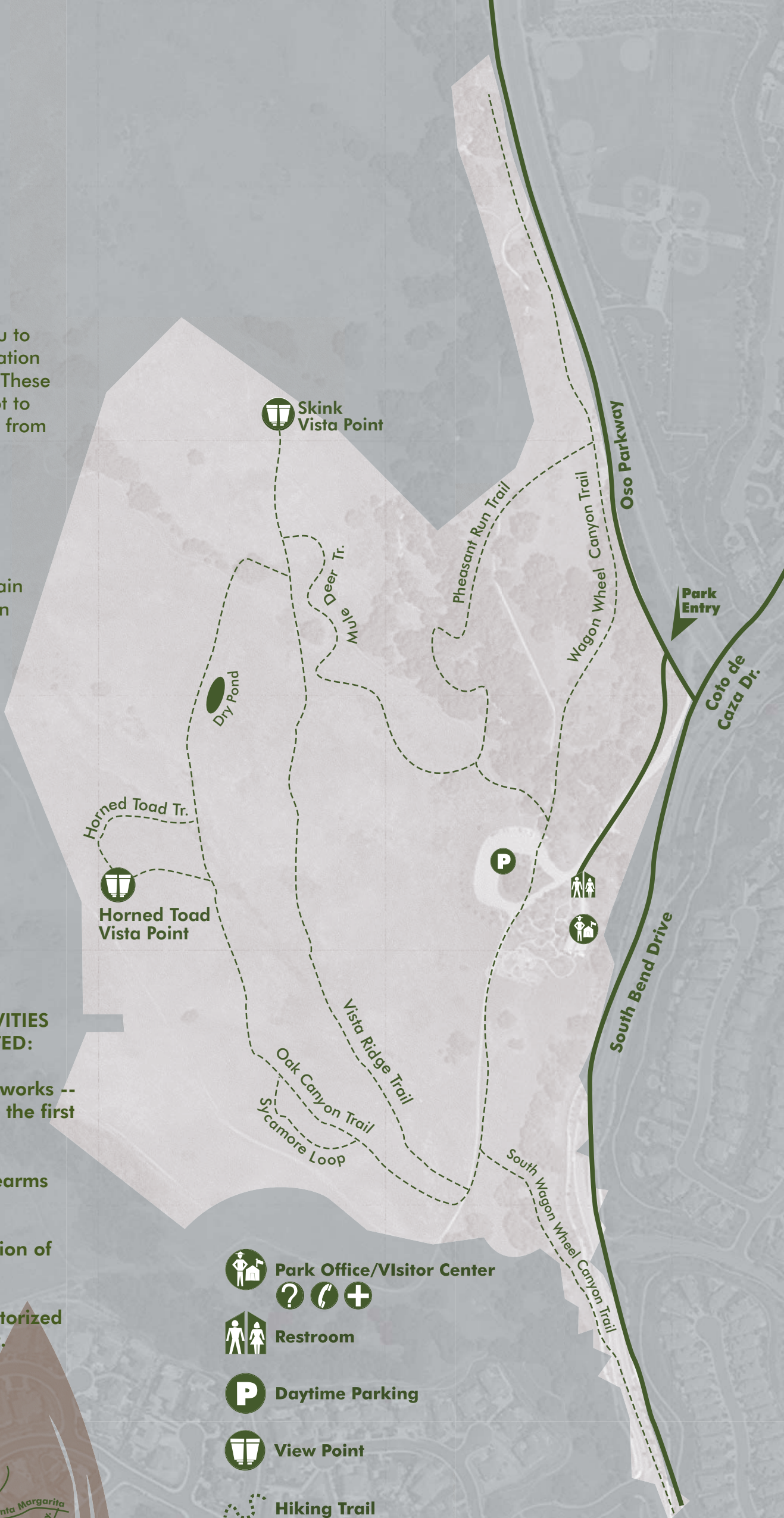
Smoking, Fires and Fireworks -- Fire prevention must be the first concern of every visitor.
