Conditions of Season Pass

1. A family membership consists of at least two people in an immediate family. Any child on a family membership must be a student attending a full-time day school, college or university and carry a student card.
2. Family is defined as immediate family members residing at the same residence of which maximum 2 are adults (*non students*).
3. The London Ski Club reserves the right to remove a season pass or lift ticket at their discretion.
4. Each season pass holder is required to sign a RELEASE OF LIABILITY form before picking up their pass.
5. A \$20.00 charge will be made for replacement of lost passes. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when replacing a lost pass.
6. Passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.
7. Season passes must be worn and visible at all times while at the ski area.
Lift ticket will not be issued for a forgotten pass.
8. The management reserves the right to close the area at any time it deems it unsafe to the public.
9. All rates are subject to change without notice.
10. Season Passes include a \$20 improvement fee per person; day tickets include a \$1.00 improvement fee for the new West Hill expansion.
11. **No refund for a season pass after Dec. 1/08, all refunds will be subject to an administration fee of \$25.**
12. Cheques are made payable to: London Ski Club.

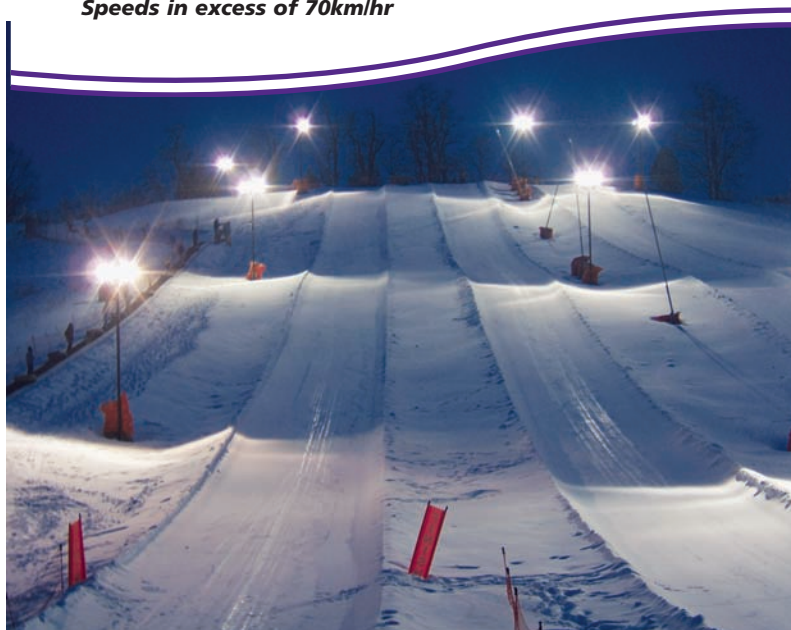

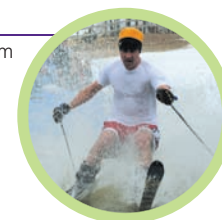

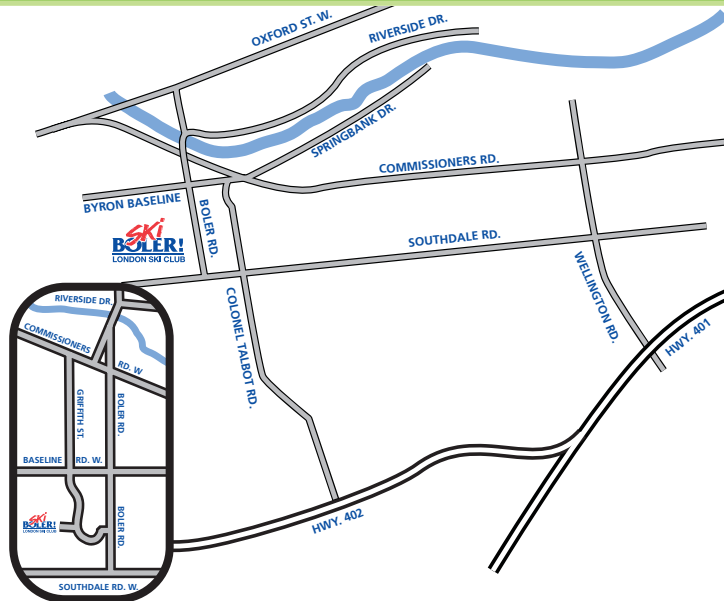

Alpine Responsibility Code

There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Regardless of how you decide to use the slopes, always show courtesy to others. Please adhere to the code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a safe outdoor experience.

1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop, or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
6. Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
7. Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
8. Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
9. You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.
10. You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.
