

- Park buildings are open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. every day except Christmas Day, Thanksgiving Day and New Year's Day.
- The Sauer-Beckmann Living History Farm is open from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. every day except Christmas Day, Thanksgiving Day and New Year's Day. Individuals and families are welcome to visit at their leisure.
- The Nature Trail: wildlife enclosures of American Bison, Texas Longhorn, and White-tailed deer: farm and park grounds and day use picnic areas are open until dark on a daily basis.
- No overnight camping.
