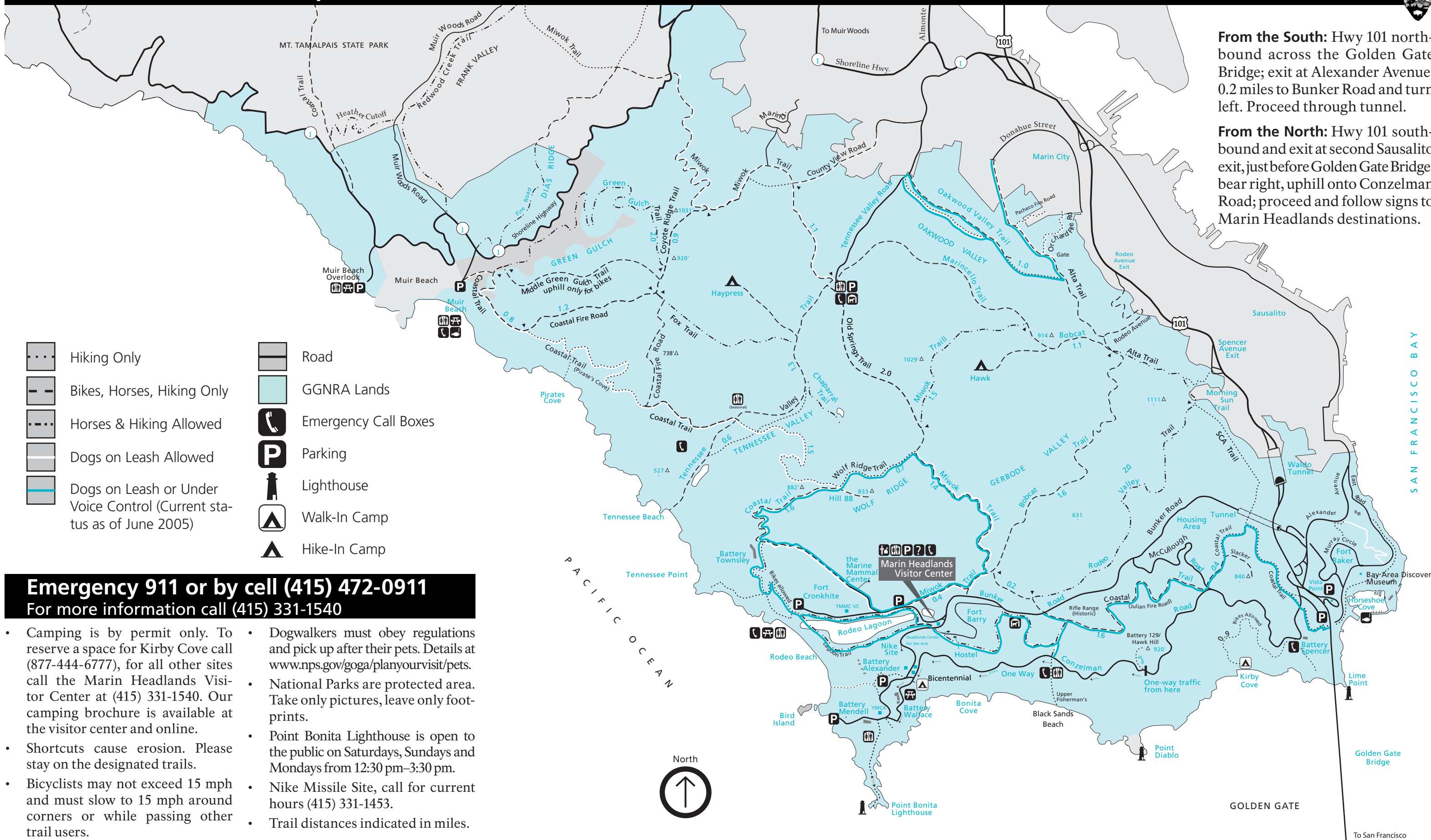


# Marin Headlands Trail Map (Updated August 2007)

**From the South:** Hwy 101 north-bound across the Golden Gate Bridge; exit at Alexander Avenue; 0.2 miles to Bunker Road and turn left. Proceed through tunnel.

**From the North:** Hwy 101 south-bound and exit at second Sausalito exit, just before Golden Gate Bridge; bear right, uphill onto Conzelman Road; proceed and follow signs to Marin Headlands destinations.

- Camping is by permit only. To reserve a space for Kirby Cove call (877-444-6777), for all other sites call the Marin Headlands Visitor Center at (415) 331-1540. Our camping brochure is available at the visitor center and online.
- Shortcuts cause erosion. Please stay on the designated trails.
- Bicyclists may not exceed 15 mph and must slow to 15 mph around corners or while passing other trail users.
- Dogwalkers must obey regulations and pick up after their pets. Details at [www.nps.gov/goga/planyourvisit/pets](http://www.nps.gov/goga/planyourvisit/pets).
- National Parks are protected area. Take only pictures, leave only footprints.
- Point Bonita Lighthouse is open to the public on Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays from 12:30 pm–3:30 pm.
