3.59 miles to Sunol Regional Wilderness boundary from Mission Peak Regional Preserve boundary. 8.66 miles from Stanford Ave. staging to Sunol Visitor Center.

OHLONE WILDERNESS TRAIL PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR EACH PERSON TO HIKE BEYOND MISSION PEAK REGIONAL PRESERVE BOUNDARY INTO S.F. WATER DISTRICT LAND ALONG THE OHLONE WILDERNESS TRAIL.
 PERMITS MAY BE PURCHASED AT THE SUNOL VISITOR CENTER, AT DEL VALLE REGIONAL PARK, OR BY CALLING (510) 562-2267.

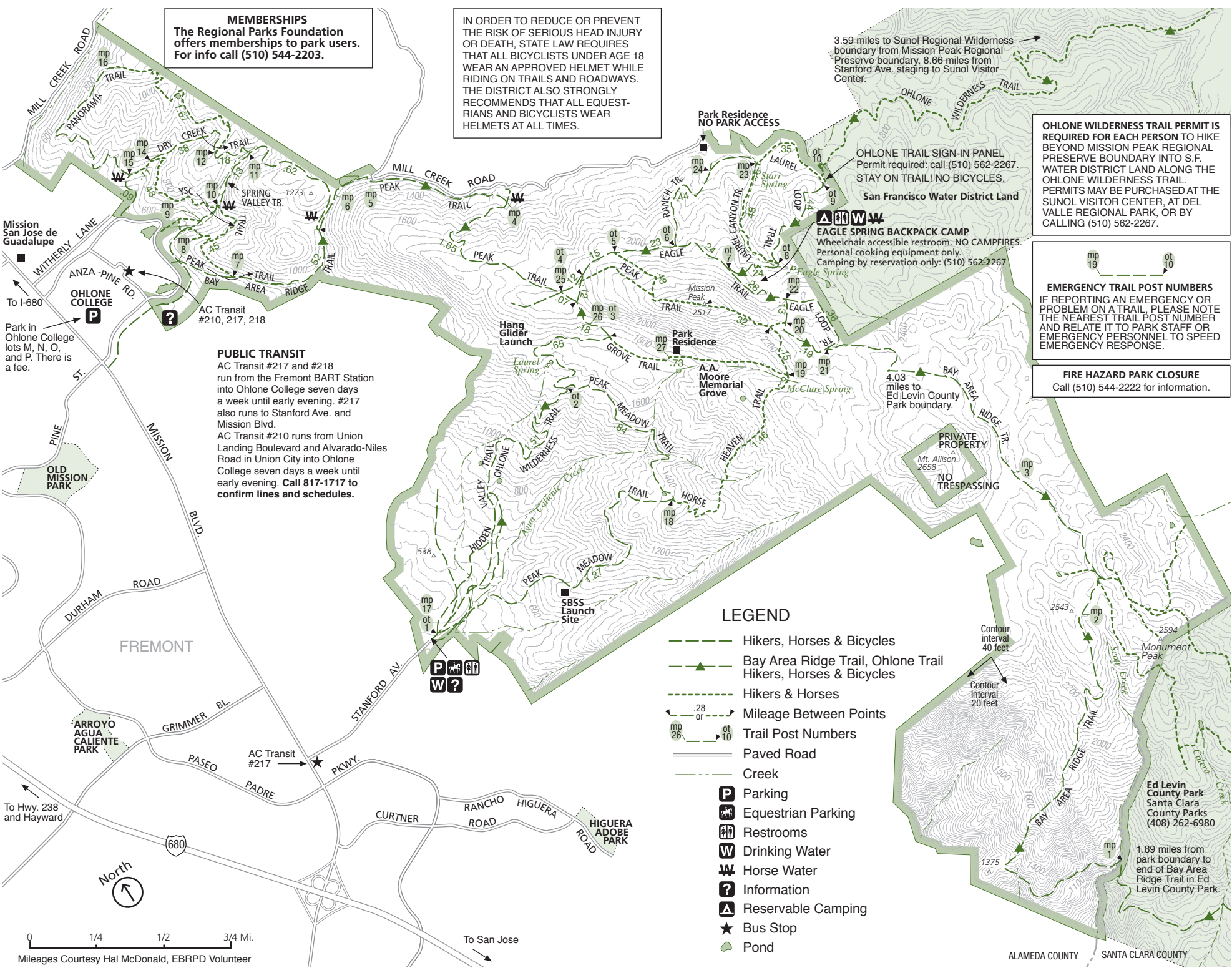
EMERGENCY TRAIL POST NUMBERS
